Talk with Texas REcap

At the January Talk with Texas RE, Texas RE's Operations and Planning Compliance Monitoring Manager Keith Smith discussed updates to Emergency Operations Reliability Standards. The effective date for EOP-004-4, EOP-005-3, EOP-006-3, and EOP-008-2 is April 1, 2019. Previous versions of these standards are retired immediately when the new standards become effective.

Retirement of IRO-006-TRE-1

On January 29, 2019, FERC issued an order approving the retirement of Regional Standard IRO-006-TRE-1: IROL and SOL Mitigation in the ERCOT Region. The retirement is effective January 29, 2019.
